



STEWARDSHIP

- Conducted grazing inspections on 903 leases on approximately 513,430 acres.
- Tree Planting:
 - Since FY 2002, 566,536 trees have been planted on 2,215 acres in the Sula
 State Forest .
- Completed tire pile cleanup in Columbus.
 - 3,000 tons of tires, 5,200 tons of soil






Sun River Game Range (Lewis and Clark County)






Number Of All Easements Issued 1997 - 2007




