# Summary of Actions July 24-25, 2008

#### LAW AND JUSTICE INTERIM COMMITTEE

## Agency oversight and bill draft review:

- ✓ Approved for drafting, legislative proposals presented by the Department of Corrections
- ✓ Approved for drafting, legislative proposals presented by the Office of State Public Defender
- ✓ Approved for drafting, the legislative proposal presented by the Judicial Branch
- ✓ Approved for drafting, legislative proposals presented by the Department of Justice

## Committee bills approved for further work:

- ✓ Approved as a committee bill and directed further work on LCyth4 revising the evaluation and placement of youth under the Youth Court Act.
- ✓ Approved as a committee bill and directed further work on LCLJC2 establishing a pilot project under the DPHHS for suicide screening and suicide prevention in detention centers.
- ✓ Approved as a committee bill and directed further work on LCdvrs providing for the diversion of mentally ill persons from the justice system; providing state funding for county-supported jail diversion and crisis intervention services and allowing for voluntary diversion from involuntary commitment of persons for mental illness.

## Committee bills approved in final form:

- ✓ LCdrug removing obsolete funding language in drug court statutes.
- ✓ LC0198 requiring an attorney in youth detention hearings unless waived after consulting an attorney.
- ✓ LC0199 adding the 22nd judicial district to the list of represented areas on the judicial nomination commission.
- ✓ LCjdg2 increasing salaries for district court judges and supreme court justices.

## Other actions:

- ✓ Appointed a subcommittee to continue work on LC7776 clarifying responsibility for payment of medical costs when a person is injured when being detained by law enforcement.
- ✓ Decided to <u>NOT</u> pursue a committee bill concerning consideration by a jury of prior offenses in certain DUI and sex offense cases and to extend sentencing to ensure enrollment in DUI treatment program.
