Proposal for Legislation -- 2011

Re: Direct Commitment to Federal Mental Health Facility

Return to:

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1. What is the problem or issue?

A number of admissions to Montana State Hospital are veterans who are eligible for treatment at VA facilities. Ft Harrison is currently building an inpatient facility which may be an appropriate facility for some of these MSH patients. Current law permits transfer of a committed patient to a federal facility, but does not clearly authorize direct commitment at the outset of the commitment case.

2. What do you want the legislation to do?

Provide clear authority for a district court to enter an initial order of commitment to a federal facility.

3. If possible, please list the MCA (Montana Code Annotated) sections that would need to be amended.

Move the language currently in 53-21-133(1), MCA, to 53-21-127(3), MCA.

4. If the proposed change requires additional funding, what funding sources do you propose?
