Use of IT Contracted Services in the Legislative Branch April 14, 2010

Historic Use Examples

- 1. Last Biennium
 - 2 Network Administrators and 1 Net Engineer left just before session used contracted services (and temp help) to get through session.
 - Did not have staff time or expertise to redesign web sight used contracted services.
 - Did not have staff time or expertise to develop Advanced Agenda used contracted services.

2. In 2005/2006

- Used a contractor to do a security assessment and help the branch develop a disaster recovery plan
- 3. In 1997/1998
 - Used multiple contractors to help develop the LAWS system did not have internal expertise nor internal staff time.
 - Used a contractor to help develop the MBARS system (in conjunction with the Executive Branch) did not have internal expertise nor internal staff time.

Contracted services is typically used in these instances

- 1. When internal staff does not have the expertise to develop the product needed.
- 2. When internal staff does not have the available time to work on the project.
- 3. When there is an emergency and additional IT staff is needed.
