A Bill for an Act entitled: "An Act defining an order and program with respect to the Department of Livestock; providing that an order be temporary in nature and may not be used to create a permanent program; and providing an immediate effective date."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Montana:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Definitions of order and program - orders to be temporary in nature. (1)(a) As used in this
chapter "order" means a command, direction, or instruction issued
by the department, board, or board's administrator in
circumstances that clearly constitute an existing imminent peril
to the public health, safety, or welfare.

- (b) An order must be temporary in nature and may be altered or rescinded as necessary to address the circumstances set out in subsection (1)(a).
 - (c) An order may not be used to create a permanent program.
- (2) As used in this chapter "program" means a legislatively or administratively created function, project, or duty of an agency.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. {standard} Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
