BACKGROUND

This Panel #2 on DUI laws and enforcement begins the committee's work on the following two study tasks as outlined in SJR 39:

- (1) identify strengths and weaknesses in Montana's current DUI statutes; and
- (2) examine laws and enforcement practices in other states, including license suspensions, technology, and available resources.

This panel is <u>not</u> designed to discuss DUI courts, post-conviction alternatives to incarceration, incarceration rates, or treatment programs. That will be the focus at the next meeting.

This panel is designed to begin examining current law on offenses and penalties and how those laws are and should be enforced.
