E. State Strategic IT Plan (2-17-522, MCA)

State Strategic Plan for IT –The plan was approved by the Governor’s Office on March 27, 2012. The plan was published on March 28, 2012.

Agency IT Plans – Agencies, with a couple of exceptions, have submitted their Agency IT Plans and related Initiative Supplements. The plans are being reviewed leading up to their approval by June 30, 2012.

G. Coordination with OBPP
