### **RE:** August Rule Review

With Bart Campbell's retirement, I am stepping into the legal administrative rule review vacuum for August. To maintain consistency, I am continuing with the rule review memorandum format that Mr. Campbell used throughout the interim for the EAIC.

### **Department of Administration - Banking and Financial Services Division**

- ✓ Proposes to amend credit union rules to redefine "limited-income person", change record retention terms, and fix terminology.
- Proposes to adopt new rules pertaining to requiring deferred deposit loan applicants to use the Nationwide Multistate Licensing System for all future licensing.
- Proposes to adopt new rules for transitioning existing escrow business company licenses to the Nationwide Multistate Licensing System and use of the system for all future licensing.
- Proposes to adopt new rules for transitioning existing consumer loan company licenses to the Nationwide Multistate Licensing System and use of the system for all future licensing.
- Proposes to adopt new rules for transitioning existing sales finance company licenses to the Nationwide Multistate Licensing System and use of the system for all future licensing.

#### **State Auditor's Office**

 $\checkmark$  Proposes to adopt a new rule pertaining to patient-centered medical homes.

#### **Department of Labor and Industry**

- ✓ Board of Occupational Therapy: Proposes to amend existing rules to provide definitions and fees related to sound and electrical modalities and topical medications; revises continuing education terms and certain qualifications.
- ✓ Building Codes Bureau: Proposes to adopt the National Electrical Code and sets fees for renewable energy installations.
- ✓ Board of Public Accountants: proposes to amend existing rules regarding public participation, fees, definitions, and use of CPA/LPA designations; clarifies terms; authorizes board discretion in review of anonymous complaints; and sets renewal deadline.

### **Department of Livestock**

- Proposes to amend existing rules pertaining to food safety and inspection service for meat and poultry.
- $\checkmark$  Proposes to amend existing rules to revise fees and terms related to brands.

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
