- ≻620 700 clients/month
- ~34,000 clients (> 6,900 unduplicated) since opening
- ≻40.8 years average age
- **≻69% male**
- ≻79% homeless or at-risk of homelessness
- ≻9% Veterans
- >81% have no payment source
- 62% have co-occurring disorders of mental health & substance abuse
- ≻44 Montana counties served
