

ADDENDUM

LC0143 - Other Changes Since June 5, 2014, SAVA Meeting *as of August 15, 2014*

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for the State Administration and Veterans' Affairs Interim Committee

Offshoots of the Simms High School mill levy election concerns:

- ✓ need better communication between schools and county election administrators;
- ✓ need a better paper trail of communication concerning the call of a school election; and
- ✓ need to clarify provisions concerning the written mail ballot plan.

LC0143 was revised to provide:

- that a request for county election administrator to run a school election must be made by a resolution of the school district trustees;
- that when a school election is called, the resolution calling for the election shall specify whether the trustees are requesting that the election be conducted by mail;
- that a resolution calling for a school election shall be transmitted to the county election administrator within 3 days;
- that if a school is going to conduct a mail ballot election, the school clerk will provide a copy of the written mail ballot plan as soon as the plan has been approved by the Secretary of State;
- clarification that an election administrator for an election to be conducted by mail shall prepare a written plan for each election and that there must be a separate plan for each type of election being conducted on the same day.
