SUMMARY OF RULE(S):

The Department of Administration is proposing to amend one rule relating to travel reimbursement claims. The proposed amendment requires relocation reimbursements to be processed in the same manner as travel reimbursements. The rule also specifies that all travel and relocation reimbursement claims must be processed through the state's central payroll system, rather than through SABHRS-Finance.
