The Commissioner of Political Practices proposes to amend one rule concerning the threshold for reporting of lobbying-related expenses. The current rule sets the adjusted payment threshold at \$2,450. As required by section 5-7-112, MCA, this amount must be adjusted for inflation pursuant to a formula. The proposed amendments will update the amount to \$2,500.
