## **SUMMARY OF RULE(S):**

The Secretary of State proposes to amend one rule pertaining to the access to public documents and fees for copies. The Secretary of State proposes to change references within the rule to statutes that were repealed by HB 123 (Ch. 348, L. 2015). HB 123 reorganized and replaced the public records statutes. The Secretary of State's rule proposal updates references within one rule to statutes repealed by HB 123 and replaced the obsolete statutes with references to the newly enacted statutes, both in the rule text and as citations for the statutes implemented by the rule.

**NOTES:** A public hearing is scheduled for December 1, 2016, at 9:30 a.m. in Room 260, State Capitol Building, Helena, Montana. The public comment period ends on December 9, 2016.
