REGISTERED WATERCRAFT IN MONTANA¹

According to the Department of Justice Motor Vehicle Division, there are currently 128,054 registered² motorized watercraft in Montana. Of those, 70,450 have validation decals issued by the Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks. These decals must be purchased every 3 years.
