SUMMARY OF RULE: The Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks issued an emergency rule closing all floating of the Smith River from Camp Baker to Eden Bridge due to intermittent ice jams that caused unsafe conditions. The emergency rule was effective from April 3, 2018, through April 10, 2018.

NOTES: Public comment will be accepted until May 11, 2018.

SUBJECT: Wake Restrictions on the Missouri River

NOTICE DESCRIPTION: Notice of Proposed Amendment

SUMMARY OF RULE: The Fish and Wildlife Commission originally proposed an amendment to the ARM 12.11.630 regarding motorized water craft use and to establish a seasonal 200 foot no wake zone on the western shoreline between the Warden Bridge and the Burlington Northern Railway Bridge No. 119.4 on the Missouri River. The purpose of the proposed rule is to protect private and public property rights. The Fish and Wildlife Commission originally proposed this rule amendment on November 9, 2017, and it was approved by the commission on April 19, 2018. However, the adoption notice could not comply with Montana Administrative Procedure Act (MAPA). Section 2-4-305(7), MCA, requires an adoption notice to be published within six months of the original notice. In order to comply with MAPA, the commission is again publishing the same notice of the proposed amendment.

NOTES: Public comment will be accepted until June 8, 2018. No public hearing is contemplated.
