Thank you for your letter of July 20, 2017. The Public Service Commission takes the concerns of legislators seriously, and although it would be inappropriate for us to address concerns raised outside the evidentiary record, I believe that the Commission's orders in these dockets did anticipate and address some of the concerns you raise.
