Awareness items

- Legislative Services is running this project in-house, saving significant budget funds for the Branch.
- Legislative Services is holding workgroups with content contributors in each division and the House and Senate during February to discuss streamlining content and web pages.

Scope/Schedule/Cost updates

- The Website Redesign team, in coordination with the Web Advisory Group (WAG), have continued to make progress replacing and updating the current website infrastructure and design.
- A Special Session of the Legislature, additional Session Systems Replacement project work, and the loss of key
 personnel caused a lag in the project schedule. However, the project team has taken these circumstances into
 account and is planning to make up for lost time in order to complete the project as intended by October 1, 2018,
 barring other unforeseen issues.
- A mock website will be available the second week of March to begin user testing.
- All website conversion work is being done using internal resources and a virtual infrastructure, meaning the overall cost for this project is minimal.
