- New hardware infrastructure built and installed - 4 servers/8 workstations
- International Roll Call (IRC) completed first release of software to Legislative Branch

- New vote system application (xmLegislator) installed and configured
- Display functionality working with Orders of Business


## Awareness Items

- During April and May 2018, Legislative Services is working with Senate and House staff on implementation and configuration
- IRC is scheduled to be on-site in June 2018 to finalize installation of the new software, including mock sessions on May 15 and June 15-21.
- IRC to be on-site during portion of 2019 Legislative Session to ensure vote system functions correctly
- Will seek funding for new digital vote boards in the 2020/2021 Interim
