A Bill for an Act entitled: "An Act allowing health insurance coverage and payments for emergency care providers of community-integrated health care; and providing an effective date."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Montana:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Coverage for services provided by emergency care providers under community-integrated health care. An insurer, health service corporation, or any employee health and welfare fund that provides health insurance benefits to residents of this state may include in group and individual insurance contracts both coverage and payment provisions for emergency care providers licensed by the board of medical examiners with an endorsement to provide community-integrated health care.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. {standard} Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 33, chapter 22, part 1, and the provisions of Title 33, chapter 22, part 1, apply to [section 1].

COORDINATION SECTION. Section 3. Coordination instruction.

This bill is void if LCVFF2 is not passed and approved.

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NEW SECTION. Section 4. {standard} Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2019.
