Amend 10-1-Part 11 (National Guard Life Insurance Reimbursement) MCA, to provide funding through the 2011 biennium.				
2. Background:				
The State of Montana currently reimburses MT National Guard members (MTNG) and Reservists (up to 16.25 per month for \$250 thousand of coverage) for Servicemember's Group Life Insurance (SGLI) insurance premiums paid while on military duty in support of contingency operations (ex. Iraqi Freedom). As of March of 2006, \$72,469.00 in SGLI premium reimbursements had been paid to qualifying MTNG members and Reservists. The funding for this progarm was only authorized through fiscal year 2007.				
3. Fiscal Impact by Fund Type:		This impact should be as sp		
Extension of this program funding will have minimal fiscal impact on the general fund. This prediction is based upon an increase in the federal death gratuity benefit, combined with a yet-to-be implemented federal allowance for partial SGLI coverage, which will likely trigger the contingent termination provisions of the reimbursement program (i.e., federally funded death gratuity and/or subsidized SGLI premiums worth a combined value of at least \$250k).
