


2021 BIENNIUM DELIVERING LOCAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (DLA)

- The 2019 Legislature approved HB 652 with \$21.5 million in funding for the DLA program: \$10.75 million for each local government and school facility projects
- The program is administered by the Department of Commerce and grants were awarded in mid-February 2020, and a full list of the projects is included on the following pages
- School facility projects were eligible for both funding types, and a total of \$11.4 million was provided for school projects, 53% of the total funds
- \$3.4 million of funds were granted to public safety and government administration facilities, 16% of total funds
 - While grants for local government facilities are occasionally made through some of the other state programs (for example, Coal Board Grants), these uses mark a departure from normal state infrastructure funding

The DLA program provided **\$21.5** million for local government infrastructure and school facility projects in the 2021 biennium. **DLA funding** leveraged a total of **\$39.6** million in other project funds, bringing an anticipated total of **\$61.1** million of infrastructure projects to the Montana
