RE: Budget Amendments

BUDGET AMENDMENT ACTIVITY

As of June 17, 2015 the Legislative Finance Division received notification of 70 budget amendments certified by the Governor since the December 2015 Legislative Finance Committee meeting.

These amendments increase total funds by \$38.1 million in FY 2015. An additional 9.83 FTE in FY 2015 and 5.85 FTE in FY 2016 in modified positions have also been added. Eleven amendments transfers existing authority between expenditure categories or between organizational units and four extend previously approved amendment authority. The figure summarizes the budget amendments certified by the Governor from the period December 2, 2014 through June 5, 2015.

Each amendment, along with a brief explanation, is summarized in the attached table. Staff has reviewed the amendments and has raised no concerns with any amendment meeting statutory criteria. It should be noted that the majority of the budget amendments were included in HB 4 as enacted by the 2015 Legislature.

The following figure summarizes the budget amendments that have been certified so far for the 2015 biennium. The various approving authorities have added a total of \$147.5 million in the 2015 biennium.
