RE: Budget Amendments

BUDGET AMENDMENT ACTIVITY

As of September 23, 2015 the Legislative Finance Division received notification of 66 budget amendments certified by the Governor since the June 2015 Legislative Finance Committee meeting.

These amendments increase total funds by \$1.6 million in FY 2015, \$15.1 million in FY 2016, and \$0.2 million in FY 2017. An additional 0.14 FTE in FY 2015, 25.56 FTE in FY 2016, and 9.96 FTE in FY 2017 in modified positions have also been added. Three amendments transfer existing authority between expenditure categories or between organizational units and three extend previously approved amendment authority. The figure summarizes the budget amendments certified by the Governor from the period June 5, 2015 through September 16, 2015.

Each amendment, along with a brief explanation, is summarized in the attached table. Staff has reviewed the amendments and has raised no concerns with any amendment meeting statutory criteria.

The following figures summarizes the budget amendments that were certified for FY 2015 and the 2017 biennium. The various approving authorities have added a total of \$97.1 million in FY 2015 and \$12.3 million in the 2017 biennium. The FY 2015 figure includes changes between fiscal years that were identified as part of quality assurance measures undertaken by the Legislative Fiscal Division.
