RE: Budget Amendments

BUDGET AMENDMENT ACTIVITY

As of February 29, 2016 the Legislative Finance Division received notification of 40 budget amendments certified by the Governor since the December 2015 Legislative Finance Committee meeting.

These amendments increase total funds \$16.7 million in fiscal year (FY) 2016, and \$1.1 million in FY 2017. An additional 6.90 full-time equivalent (FTE) in FY 2016, and 3.19 FTE in FY 2017 in modified positions have also been added. Three amendments transfer existing authority between expenditure categories or between organizational units and two extend previously approved amendment authority. The figure summarizes the budget amendments certified by the Governor from the period December 1, 2015 through February 29, 2015.
