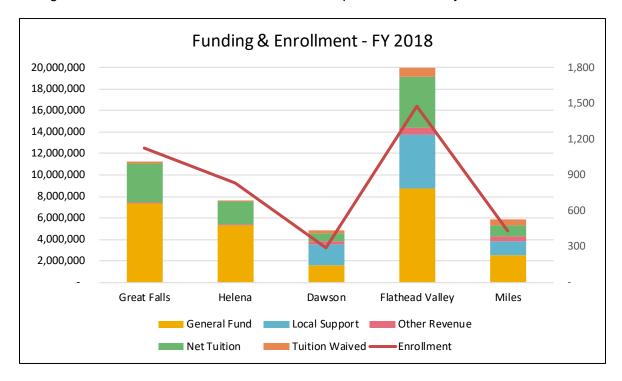

RE: Additional Data: Community College Funding Formula Report

During the September LFC meeting, there were several requests for additional data points in reference to the Community College Funding Formula Review. Primarily, the request was to expand the data points to include the 4-year campuses. This memo is to provide the requested data and responses to your questions.

Comparative Funding

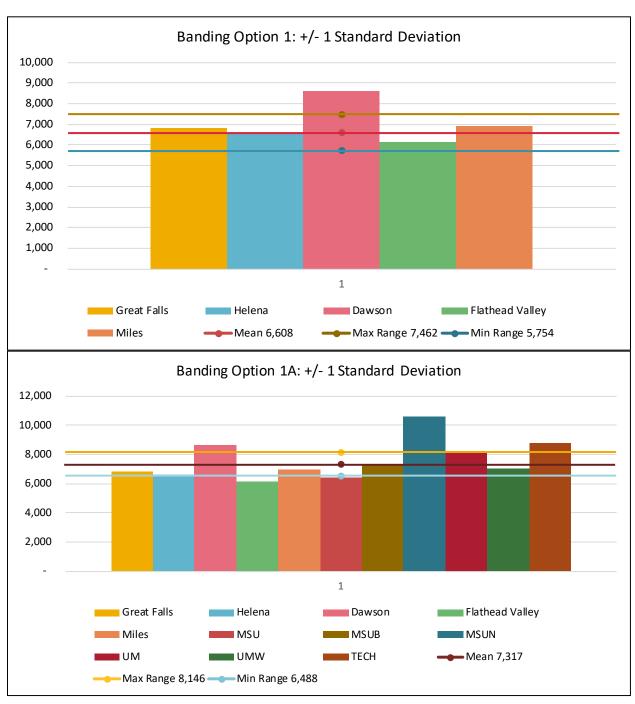
Presented in the report appendix was a chart on comparative funding for FY 2018 for the 2-year campuses of Montana. The original chart was based on what percent of their total budget accounted for general fund, local support, other revenue, net tuition, and tuition waived. The following chart is the dollar amounts each of the campuses received by the same sources.



Banding

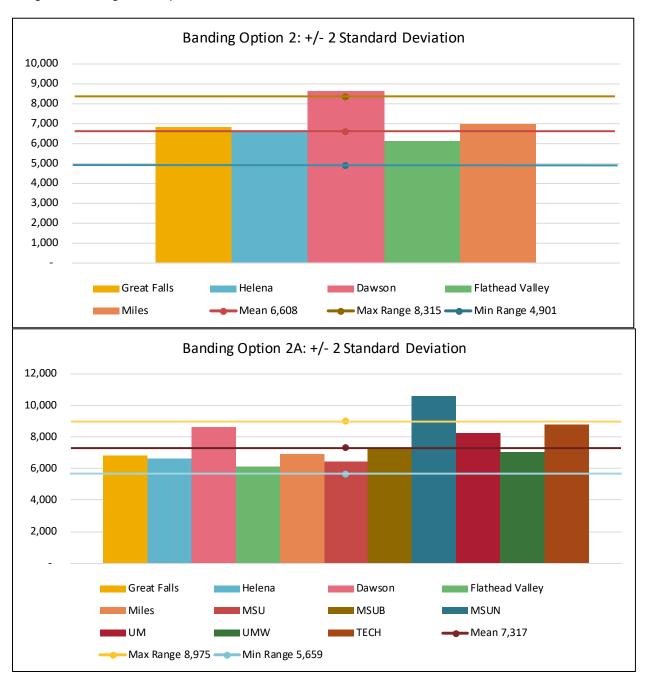
The analysis utilized a 6-year weighted average of state support per resident FTE with a standard deviation of the same 6-year data range. The use of standard deviation is due to its statistical relevance and correlation to data relevant to the colleges.

Banding Option 1 provides the comparison of the banding option presented at the September LFC meeting, which compared the community colleges and 2-year colleges. Banding Option 1A compares the community colleges to a band based on all public 2 and 4-year colleges within Montana. This first set of tables is based on plus or minus one standard deviation from the 6-year weighted average.



Banding option 1 is a plus or minus one standard deviation of 854 from the six-year weighted average of 6,608. Including the 4-year colleges (Banding Option 1A) in the analysis adjusts the standard deviation to 829 and the six-year weighted average to 7,317.

An alternate option was presented in the review to utilize a plus or minus two standard deviations from the weighted average. Below are the charts that represent the same six-year weighted averages with plus or minus two standard deviations.



Banding Option 2 is a plus or minus two standard deviations of 854 from the six-year weighted average of 6,608. Including the 4-year colleges (Banding Option 2A) in the analysis adjusts the standard deviation to 829 and the six-year weighted average to 7,317.

<u>Current Unrestricted Expenditures</u>

The current unrestricted expenditures are those expenditures that are funded with state general fund, six-mill levy or local support if applicable, and tuition and fees. Current unrestricted expenditures are those expenditures that are directly correlated to students and the cost of education based on program function. The following tables compare expenditures from FY 2013 to FY 2018 by college.
