Exceptions Granted to State Agencies (2-17-515, MCA) (July-September 2018)

- The Department of Administration was granted an exception request to the POL-Information Security Policy for six months, with the stipulation that by the end of November 2018, a plan must be agreed upon and documented by SABHRS Team and SITSD Management. This exception expires at the end of February 2019.
- 2. The Montana Lottery was granted an exception request to the Executive Order No. 09-2016 referencing the restrictive terms and conditions described in the provided justification document for one year, ending September 5, 2019.
- 3. The Department of Labor and Industry was granted an exception request to the POL-Information Security Policy for the Montana Prescription Drug Registry services and allow pharmacies to upload reports of prescriptions filled to this registry application for six months, ending March 10, 2019.
- 4. The Montana State Fund was granted an exception request to the POL-Information Security Policy providing the flexibility needed to service their customer base with appropriate security controls for three months, ending December 10, 2018.
- 5. The Department of Labor and Industry was granted three separate exception requests to the POL-Information Security Policy for three months, ending December 10, 2018. SITSD will invite the appropriate DLI and SITSD staff to discuss a plan to address each request.
- 6. The Department of Administration was granted an exception request to the POL-Information Security Policy on the Mainframe system for one year, ending September 10, 2019.
- 7. The Montana State Library was granted an exception request to the POL-Information Security Policy allowing GIS professionals across the state to access the MSL FTP sites to download data for six months, ending March 10, 2019.
- 8. The Secretary of State's office was granted an exception request to the POL-Information Security Policy for the understanding outlined in the MOU that was agreed upon by SITSD and SOS.
- 9. The Department of Administration was granted an exception request to the POL-Information Security Policy allowing the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) users to keep their computer specific settings.
