### **Issue #17**

#### **State Auditor**

6.6.8501, 6.6.8502, 6.6.8507 Changes to Montana Viatical Settlement Act that covers insurance policies covering terminally or chronically ill insureds adopted by 2005 Legislature.

#### **Board of Nursing**

8.32.427 Medication aide and training programs - allowing examination to be held elsewhere than just Helena.

### **Issue #18**

#### **Dept. of Commerce**

Rules I through XVI -- implementing the Big Sky Economic Development Program.

#### **Board of Psychologists**

24.189.2107 Continuing education implementation. Modifying the administration of continuing education for psychologists.

Rule I Fee abatement. Allowing department to implement fee abatements as necessary to avoid excess cash accumulation.

#### **Dept. of Livestock**

32.23.301 Licensee assessments -- increasing fee for milk inspections from \$0.135 to \$0.15 per hundredweight to be commensurate with costs.

### **Issue #19**

#### **Dept. of Labor**

##### **Crane and Hoisting Engineers Program**

24.135.501, 516, 530 and new rules I through VI -- implementing HB 401, L. 2005, generally revising laws relating to crane and hoisting operating engineers.

##### **Board of Medical Examiners**

new rules I and II -- rule I deals with medical assistants and their scope or practice and type of supervision to which they are subject.

Rule II authorizes the dept. to abate fees when necessary.

**Board of Private Adolescent Residential or Outdoor Programs**

new rules I through VI -- implements HB 628, L. 2005, requiring the board to examine the benefit of licensing private alternative adolescent residential or outdoor programs.

**Board of Accountants**

new rules I through IV, 8.54.410, 415, 802, 803, 804, and 808 -- pertaining to fees, amount or required experience, continuing education, and special practice permits for nonresidents.
