Current law sets the examination fee at \$300 per day per examiner.				
2. Background: 31-1-810, MCA, and 31-1-711,	MCA require a	licensee to nav	to BEID a fee of \$300 a da	y for each examiner
conducting an examination. The current statutory rate does not cover the cost of employee salaries, benefits, travel time, travel expenses, and lodging. BFID estimates that it loses from \$200 to \$250 per examination. The department is self-funded through examination and licensing fees. BFID cannot meet its expenses unless the law is changed.				
3. Fiscal Impact by Fund Type: This impact should be as specific as possible. The licensee examined will pay the actual cost of examinations, including travel time, and expenses, actual				
cost of lodging, and examiner salaries, and benefits for the time spent on examinations. The estimated increase will be \$200 to \$250 per examination.
