ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. As of March 2001, twenty Montana teachers have achieved certification from the national board for professional teaching standards.
- 2. In FY02, ten full-time classroom teachers will be eligible for the \$3,000 stipend. (10 x 3,000=30,000).
- 3. In FY03, ten full-time classroom teachers will be eligible for the \$3,000 stipend. (10 x 3,000=30,000).
- 4. The Office of Public Instruction will pay the stipend directly to the eligible teacher. No deductions for taxes or retirement will be taken from the payment.
- 5. HB 42 does not contain an appropriation for the teacher stipends. The appropriation for the stipends is included in HB 2 as of Senate Finance and Claims.
