Department of Corrections

1. HB 77 allows for additional penalty for criminal distribution of dangerous drugs if that crime is committed within 1000 feet of a municipal housing authority.
2. The impact cannot be discerned because the number of cases where the individual sells drugs within 1,000 feet of a municipal housing unit is unknown and cannot be determined due to the lack of reliable data on where the crimes were committed.
3. This may have a fiscal impact if it leads to longer periods of incarceration.
4. Department of Justice has no fiscal impact.
