TECHNICAL NOTES:

1. The Child Support Enforcement Division (CSED) does not have statutory authority to register these orders for DPHHS as specified in the legislation. Currently the CSED maintains the Central Case Registry of support orders. All support orders entered by the clerks of court in Montana have a domestic violence indicator on them when entered. This information is then transmitted to the CSED with the indicator.
