# **Fiscal Analysis**

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. The salary, benefits, travel expenses and education costs for a district court judge are paid by the state general fund. Staffing, office space and operating costs are paid by local government.
- 2. Salary and benefits for a district court judge are \$114,409 per year, which is the rate set in statute.
- 3. The calculation for salary and benefits include 2 judges for 6 months in FY 2002, and 2 judges for a full year in FY 2003. Initial training costs for a new judge are approximately \$2,000.
- 4. Annual travel expenses are estimated at \$5,000 per judge.
- 5. Initial purchase and set-up for a computer and software is a one-time cost of \$3,000 per judge.

## EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

Local governments must provide staffing, office space, and operating expenses for the additional judges. These expenses vary by location, depending on the current availability of office space, whether a secretary is needed or can be shared, and whether a law clerk is needed.

### LONG-RANGE IMPACTS:

The annual general fund expenditures for state government would be approximately \$239,000 in FY 2003 and thereafter. Two additional district court judges could reduce the backlog of court cases, speed up the judicial process, and increase the efficiency of the court system as a whole.
