ASSUMPTIONS:

1. HB 238 requires county attorneys to consult with the victims of a juvenile felony offense prior to releasing the offender from a detention center or shelter care pending a probable cause hearing. Counties are currently responsible for incarceration costs incurred for these juveniles.
2. Increased incarceration costs by counties may result from this legislation.
