## Fiscal Analysis

## ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The bill includes an appropriation for $\$ 700,000$ to pay each supervising teacher a stipend of $\$ 500$. The bill requires the amount to be prorated if the appropriation is less than the total amount for which supervising teachers qualify.
2. The Montana University System has 1,772 student teachers on a one-to-one basis in public schools each year. Prorating the amount appropriated in the bill would provide a $\$ 395$ stipend to each supervising teacher.
3. If $\$ 500$ was paid to each supervising teacher, the total cost is estimated to be $\$ 886,000$. This is $\$ 186,000$ above the appropriated amount in the bill.
