## **Department of Environmental Quality**

- 1. Coal bed methane operations with water discharges to state waters will be permitted in the usual permitting program process.
- 2. Water quality from coal bed methane projects typically does not meet the exemption, so projects still will need a permit in most cases. Therefore, the bill language will not have a significant effect on numbers of permits needed.
- 3. The current drilling moratorium until an EIS is prepared will delay any new permit applications until it is completed about halfway through the 2003 biennium.
