ASSUMPTIONS:

Department of Environmental Quality

1. Coal bed methane operations with water discharges to state waters will be permitted in the usual permitting program process.
2. Water quality from coal bed methane projects typically does not meet the exemption, so projects still will need a permit in most cases. Therefore, the bill language will not have a significant effect on numbers of permits needed.
3. The current drilling moratorium until an EIS is prepared will delay any new permit applications until it is completed about halfway through the 2003 biennium.
