## **Fiscal Analysis**

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

#### **Department of Commerce**

- 1. The work associated with the initial implementation of HB 313 would be absorbed within the existing staff assigned to the Board of Social Work Examiners and Professional Counselors. The board will conduct one special meeting each fiscal year in order to draft rules as required by Section 3, and to approve the applications for certification as a domestic violence counselor and facilitator. Per diem is \$50/day and there are seven members on the board for a total cost of \$350. Travel costs for one meeting of the board are \$1,500, which includes commercial airfare rates for members located in remote locations.
- 2. Additional operating expenses in FY 2002 include ARM filing fees (10 pages @\$35 = \$350), and a court reporter for the administrative rule hearing (\$500).

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- 3. It is estimated that approximately 5 counselors would apply in the FY 2002 and 25 in FY 2003 for the certification, and that they would pay an application fee of approximately \$50. It is not known how many applications would be received for facilitators for psycho-educational groups, but it is anticipated that the application fee would be approximately \$50.
- 4. There would be an additional renewal fee of about \$25 for individuals who have the certification for a counselor or facilitator.
