## EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

This bill proposes to take \$29,000 from the annual fuel tax allocation to cities and \$17,000 from the annual fuel tax allocation to counties and to increase the Montana Local Technical Assistance Program in Bozeman. This will result in a 0.28% decrease in payments to cities, and 0.27% decrease to counties.
