### **Fiscal Analysis**

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. If HB 294 (increase GABA from 1.5 to 3%) and SB 89 (reduce waiting period for GABA from 3 years to 1 year) both pass, the employee contribution rate will increase from 6.9 percent to 10.56 percent, but the member will pay this cost. If other provisions are enacted, the cost associated with this provision may be different.
- 2. About 18 of the estimated 75 eligible PERS members will switch to the Game Wardens and Peace Officers Retirement System (GWPORS).
- 3. The cost to the general fund will be the increase in the employer's contribution rate from 6.9 percent in PERS to 9.0 percent in the GWPORS. Average salary for the first year of the biennium is \$23,958 and will increase 4 percent for the second year of the biennium.
