Fiscal Analysis

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. In FY2001, the only school district that is receiving an additional basic entitlement under 20-9-311(8)(a)(iv) is the Helena Elementary District, which consolidated with the Kessler School District in FY2001.
- 2. Under current law, Helena Elementary District will be eligible for an additional basic entitlement in FY2001, FY2002 and FY2003.
- 3. If HB 488 is approved, the fiscal impact to the state will not be felt until FY2004.

LONG-RANGE IMPACTS:

The impact to the state will not be felt until FY2004. The state general fund impact is expected to be less than \$12,000 in that year. Local districts that choose to consolidate, may have slightly higher local property taxes to support the district for the three years that this bill impacts.
