Fiscal Analysis

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. In FY2001, the only school district that is receiving an additional basic entitlement under 20-9-311(8)(a)(iv) is the Helena Elementary District, which consolidated with the Kessler School District in FY2001.
2. Under current law, Helena Elementary District will be eligible for an additional basic entitlement in FY2001, FY2002 and FY2003.
3. If HB 488 is approved, the fiscal impact to the state will not be felt until FY2004.

LONG-RANGE IMPACTS:

The impact to the state will not be felt until FY2004. The state general fund impact is expected to be less than \$12,000 in that year. Local districts that choose to consolidate, may have slightly higher local property taxes to support the district for the three years that this bill impacts.
