Fiscal Analysis

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. This is the only provision being considered. If other provisions are enacted, the cost associated with this provision may be different.
- 2. The number of volunteer firefighters will not increase significantly above the current level of 2,500.
- 3. No change will occur in retirement patterns.
- 4. The contributions from the Fire Insurance Premium Tax Fund will continue at the current rate of 5% of the premium taxes collected on certain fire risks.
- 5. The increased benefits will cost approximately \$900,000.
- 6. The contributions currently paid into the system are sufficient to fund the increased benefits.
