Fiscal Analysis

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Payment to the Education Commission of the States (ECS) of state fees is not a necessary condition of joining the ECS. ECS encourages members to pay state dues, but it allows a state to be a member without paying state dues.
- 2. SB60 does not contain an appropriation for joining ECS.
- 3. According to the staff at ECS, if Montana were to pay state dues in FY 2002, the approximate cost would be \$43,700. The FY 2003 is expected to be approximately 4% higher than the FY 2003 cost.

LONG-RANGE IMPACTS:

At some point in the future, Montana may need to pay state dues in order to continue its membership in the Education Commission of the States.
