EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

- 1. There will be no additional costs to local governments as a result of this bill, particularly in counties.
- 2. Municipalities would experience an insignificant increase in advertising costs since the bill requires two publications of notice where municipalities are currently required to make only one publication.
- 3. If counties or municipalities choose to use radio or television advertising to supplement published notice, advertising cost could increase; however, the amount is not determinable since this is an option and not a requirement and it is unknown which entities may exercise this option.
