Fiscal Analysis

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. As SB 320 currently reads, there will be no impact to the state until an ethanol plant is in full production.
- 2. There will be no plant in production until the 2005 biennium.

LONG-RANGE IMPACTS:

- 1. The 2001 State of Montana Spring Bid for vehicles resulted in vehicles that can be powered by renewable fuels as the successful bidder at \$15,453 per vehicle. This was lower than other vehicles that do not have the renewable fuel option.
- 2. E-85 fuel is currently approximately \$.35 higher than gasoline purchased through the state bulk fuel contract and will remain so.
