#### **Department of Commerce**

1. SB 389 provides for the implementation of a crop insurance program that may include fire insurance as an option when providing hail insurance for crops.
2. SB 389 as introduced, has no fiscal impact on the Department of Commerce.

**Department of Agriculture**

3. Actuarial review required to establish premiums, coverage rates, and reserve fund estimated at \$5,000.
4. There will be 2 additional Hail Board meetings to discuss proposed fire insurance estimate at \$2,000.
