ASSUMPTIONS:

Department of Commerce:

- 1. This bill clarifies the requirements for certification of long term care facilities that provide intermediate and skilled nursing care.
- 2. Section 3 of the bill as introduced, requires that standards be defined for the reporting of any substandard practice of a physician to the Board of Medical Examiners. The number of complaints that will be filed alleging substandard practice of a physician is unknown. The Board of Medical Examiners would be able to absorb an increase of 10 to 15 new complaints each year based upon the budget as currently contained in HB 2.
