| 15 | "60-5-110. Commercial enterprise or structure prohibited exception. (1) Except as provided in |
| 16 | 60-5-505 and subsection (2) of this section, no a commercial enterprise or structure shall may not be constructed |
| 17 | or operated on the publicly owned or leased right-of-way of a controlled-access highway or controlled-access |
| 18 | facility or on any publicly leased land used in connection therewith. |
| 19 | (2) The department may, under the terms and conditions that it considers appropriate, install or allow |
| 20 | others to install electronic communication equipment or electronic informational kiosks on the right-of-way of |
| 21 | any state highway, including a controlled-access facility. The department may charge a fee for the use of the |
| 22 | equipment or kiosk. The fees must be deposited in the nonrestricted highway state special revenue account |
