| 8 | WHEREAS, the use of daylight saving time is inconvenient in that it requires time changes twice in a |
| 9 | calendar year; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, a decision by Montana to use only mountain standard time would be compatible with |
| 11 | Montana's border states because there would be only a 1-hour time difference for one-half of the year between |
| 12 | most border states and Montana if Montana did not participate in daylight saving time; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, a decision by Montana to use only mountain standard time would be compatible with |
| 14 | Saskatchewan, Canada, because Saskatchewan does not use daylight saving time; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, the use of daylight saving time is controlled by federal law, specified in 15 U.S.C. 260a, |
| 16 | which allows states that lie entirely within one time zone the option of using only standard time if state law |
| 17 | requires the entire state to use only standard time. |

| 19 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: |

| 21 | NEW SECTION. Section 1. Only mountain standard time to be used. The standard time in Montana |
| 22 | to be used by the state, its political subdivisions, and all persons within the state at all times is the solar time of |
| 23 | the meridian 105 degrees west of Greenwich, England, commonly known as mountain standard time, and is |
| 24 | never the time achieved by a temporary 1-hour advancement of time, commonly known as daylight saving time, |
| 25 | provided for in 15 U.S.C. 260a. |

| 27 | NEW SECTION. Section 2. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a |
| 28 | copy of [this act] to each tribal government located on the seven Montana reservations and to the Little Shell |
| 29 | band of Chippewa. |
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1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective November 1, 2003.

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
