11	Section 1. Section 39-29-101, MCA, is amended to read:						
12	"39-29-101. Definitions. For the purposes of this chapter, the following definitions apply:						
13	(1) "Active duty" means full-time duty with military pay and allowances in the armed forces, except for						
14	training, determining physical fitness, or service in the reserve or national guard.						
15	(2)(1) "Armed forces" means the United States :						
16	(a) <u>United States</u> army, navy, air force, marine corps, and coast guard; and						
17	(b) merchant marine for service recognized by the United States department of defense as active						
18	military service for the purpose of laws administered by the department of veterans affairs; and						
19	(c) Montana army and air national guard.						
20	(3)(2) "Disabled veteran" means a person:						
21	(a) whether or not the person is a veteran as defined in this section, who was separated under						
22	honorable conditions from active military duty in the armed forces and has established the present existence						
23	of a service-connected disability or is receiving compensation, disability retirement benefits, or \underline{a} pension						
24	because of a law administered by the department of veterans affairs, or a military department, or the state of						
25	Montana; or						
26	(b) who has received a purple heart medal.						
27	(4)(3) "Eligible relative" means:						
28	(a) the unmarried surviving spouse of a veteran or disabled veteran;						
29	(b) the spouse of a disabled veteran who is unable to qualify for appointment to a position;						
30	(c) the mother of a veteran who died under honorable conditions while serving in the armed forces if:

- 1 (i) the mother's spouse is totally and permanently disabled; or
- 2 (ii) the mother is the widow of the father of the veteran and has not remarried;
- 3 (d) the mother of a service-connected permanently and totally disabled veteran if:
- 4 (i) the mother's spouse is totally and permanently disabled; or
- 5 (ii) the mother is the widow of the father of the veteran and has not remarried.
- 6 (4) "Military duty" means duty with military pay and allowances in the armed forces.
- 7 (5) (a) "Position" means a position occupied by a permanent, temporary, or seasonal employee, as 8 defined in 2-18-101, for the state or a similar permanent, temporary, or seasonal employee with a public 9 employer other than the state.
- 10 (b) The term does not include:
- 11 (a)(i) a state or local elected office;
- 12 (b)(ii) appointment by an elected official to a body, such as a board, commission, committee, or council;
- 13 (c)(iii) appointment by an elected official to a public office if the appointment is provided for by law;
- 14 (d)(iv) a department head appointment by the governor or an executive department head appointment 15 by a mayor, city manager, county commissioner, or other chief administrative or executive officer of a local 16
- 17 (e)(v) engagement as an independent contractor or employment by an independent contractor.

- 19 (a) a department, office, board, bureau, commission, agency, or other instrumentality of the executive, 20 legislative, or judicial branches of the government of this state;
- 21 (b) a unit of the Montana university system;
- 22 (c) a school district or community college; and
- 23 (d) a county, city, or town.
 - (7) "Scored procedure" means a written test, structured oral interview, performance test, or other selection procedure or a combination of these procedures that results in a numerical score to which percentage points may be added.
 - (8) (a) "Under honorable conditions" means a discharge or separation from active military duty characterized by the armed forces as under honorable conditions. The term includes honorable discharges and general discharges.

- 2 (9) "Veteran" means a person who:
 - (a) was separated under honorable conditions from active <u>federal military</u> duty in the armed forces after having served more than 180 consecutive days, other than for training; or
 - (b) as a member of a reserve component under an order of active federal duty pursuant to 10 U.S.C. 12301(a), (d), or (g), 10 U.S.C. 12302, or 10 U.S.C. 12304 served on active duty during a period of war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge is authorized and was discharged or released from duty under honorable conditions; or
 - (c) is or has been a member of the Montana army or air national guard and who has satisfactorily completed a minimum of 6 years service in the armed forces, the last 3 years of which have been served in the Montana army or air national guard."
